

Dear Parent/Carer and Player

Welcome

On behalf of the Cinderford RFC Mini and Youth section, I would like to welcome you and your child to the club and provide you with some information about the activities we carry out. The club provides rugby playing opportunities for young people between the ages of 7 and 19 (Under 7 through to Colts level) – both coaching and playing participation is provided (RFU endorsed). Our RFU qualified coaches have been screened for their suitability for working with young people.

We welcome parents to all training and competitions – your support is valued. Information about training times and dates, and details regarding travel arrangements, kit and club registration is provided below.

Training

Training takes place on Wednesday evenings [times will be confirmed by your youngsters Coach] and Sundays from 10 a.m. All old and new players are WELCOME – so let's make this another successful season!

Travel

Arrangements should be made for your child to travel to and from training sessions and matches. We appreciate it if children can arrive and be collected promptly. If you are going to be late picking your child up, please contact your head coach and let them know.

Costs & Membership

Last year, the cost of Mini and Youth section rugby was just over £25,000. We thank our Volunteers and Sponsors for their continued support.

The Minis (up to Under 12) will pay £25.00 membership and the Youths (under 13 to 19) will pay £35.00 membership. Membership fees are payable by the end of September 2011 and your head coach will start collecting your subscription from the beginning of September – please see your coach if you have any queries. Membership will include free admission to watch First team games, providing that youngsters show their Membership cards to those on the admission gate.

This year we have several new procedures and forms that need to be filled in, please insert the information requested and return this form to the head coach of your team. For safety reasons, it is important that the club is informed of any medical condition or allergies that may be relevant to your child, in particular if your child should fall ill or be involved in an accident while at the club. If you are under 16, please ask your parents or guardian to sign this form before it is returned.

This form must be completed and returned to your child's head coach on or before Sunday, 25th September, if we have not received this information, your child will not be allowed to participate. We will also use the information to ensure that you are kept informed about club events.
